eladio dieste was born in artigas, uruguay, 1917. he enrolled in the engineering school of montevidéo, graduating in 1943. in 1946 dieste realized his first reinforced brick vault while collaborating with the catalan architect antoní bonet on the berlinghieri house in punta ballena, uruguay. in 1954, dieste and eugenio montañez formed a partnership for both design and construction. dieste continued his work despite a degenerative disease that after 1995 left him confined to his home. eladio dieste died on july 29, 2000, in montevidéo.

yoshihiro asada was born in nara prefecture, japan, in 1964. he studied photography at the osaka university of arts. he lives in tokyo where he is a staff photographer for the architectural magazines shinken-chiku and jyutakutokushu.
